In California, students are **guaranteed a voice** in planning and budgeting for their school district. **The Local Control Funding Formula**, or LCFF, requires that districts consult with students, parents, teachers and community members each spring to create an official plan for the coming years.



Launched by the California Alliance for Arts Education, the **Student Voices Campaign** is a creative way for young people to make their voices heard in their school district.

YOUR VOICE

Create a **video** of two minutes or less that shows your vision for your school.

YOUR VISION
